Members of the public can address the Redistricting Commission in the following ways:

- Attend a meeting in person. Participants may complete a blue comment upon arrival at themeeting, or download a copy of <u>comment card</u> [PDF] and hand in at the meeting.
- Submit an <u>online comment card</u> at least 1 hour prior to the start of the meeting. If you want to speak at the meeting, you will need to indicate on the comment card that you would like tospeak during the meeting, and you will need to call 888-788-0099 or 877-853-5247 (toll free) using meeting ID 5301232921 and following the prompts, prior to the start of the **meeting. You will be able to listen to the meeting; and when the item you have indicated that you want to speak on is before the board, your line will be taken off mute and you will be given an opportunity to speak.**
