

This is just over 2,700 calls a month







Animal Control enforces the Mesa City Codes that pertain to animals which include but not limited to:

- * Dog at large (dog off leash)
- * Animal quarantine
- * Animal licensing
- * Livestock violations
- * Animal Noise disturbance
- * Unsanitary premises






As well, Animal Control works in close connection with the Mesa Police Department and Mesa Fire. We also investigate animal cruelty, respond to injured animals and removal of certain wildlife.



All dogs are required to be currently licensed, just as vehicle registration.

For The City of Mesa,

The City of Mesa launched its Trap, Neuter, Return (TNR) program in February 2025. The initiative currently partners with four veterinary clinics and is supported by more than 170 dedicated Mesa residents who generously volunteer their time to help manage and care for the community cat population.
