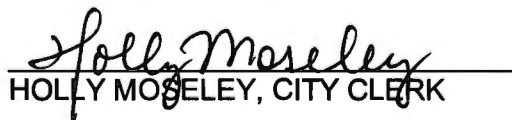

Without objection, the Study Session adjourned at 5:27 p.m.

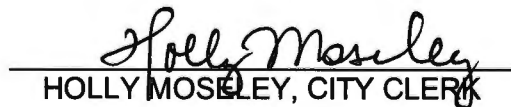
