The City Council of the City of Mesa met in a Study Session in the lower-level meeting room of the Council Chambers, 57 East 1st Street, on December 4, 2023, at 5:15 p.m.

Mayor Giles conducted a roll call.

1. Review and discuss items on the agenda for the December 4, 2023, Regular Council meeting.

In response to a question from Councilmember Freeman on Item 4-b, (Dollar Limit Increase to the Term Contract for Leasing Hotel Rooms for Off the Streets Emergency Housing Program for the Community Services Department (Citywide)), on the Regular Council meeting agenda, City Manager Christopher Brady confirmed that the contract should be adjusted to allow for the additional 25 rooms for a total of 110 rooms. He explained the hotel has separate buildings that have additional rooms in them that should have been included in the original terms, therefore prompting an increase to the contract.

In response to a question from Councilmember Freeman on Item 5-d, (Approving and authorizing the City Manager to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Casa Grande, City of Maricopa, Town of Florence, Town of Payson, Superstition Fire and Medical District, Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation, and the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community. The agreement will allow fire fighter personnel of these government entities to attend fire service training hosted by the Mesa Fire and Medical Department.), on the Regular Council meeting agenda, Mr. Brady stated that the General Fund will be used, adding that the City is not allowed to use federal dollars for Public Safety.
