1. Approval of the minutes of the Transportation Advisory Board meeting held on March 21, 2023.
2. Acknowledge outgoing Board Members Ryan Wozniak and Sam Gatton.

Mesa City Code requires that the Transportation Advisory Board select their own Chairperson and Vice Chairperson from among their members to serve a one-year term. By-laws state that no board member shall serve more than two consecutive full terms as Chairperson or Vice Chairperson. Board members who have served two consecutive full terms as an officer may be reelected to that office after at least one intervening year on the Board during which he/she does not serve as that officer. Partial terms as an officer shall not be counted towards term limits. The term of Chairperson and Vice Chairperson will begin at the July 2023 Transportation Advisory Board meeting.
