**Step 2: Staff evaluation; Fire Department Approval** 

**Step 3:** Conduct Speed Study (speed & volume)

Step 4: Neighborhood Acceptance Survey (300')

If speed and volume criteria have been met

At least 70% of affected owners must approve


**Step 5: Neighborhood Denial Survey (600')** *If 70% of affected owners approved Less than 70% of affected owners* are opposed

**Step 6: Public comment period** 

**Step 7:** Transportation Advisory Board (TAB) Approval

### **Neighborhood Survey Area**








FIGURE 1 - PRESTON ST LOCATION MAP





#### DISCUSSION – PRESTON STREET

- 25 MPH POSTED SPEED LIMIT
- 35.3 MPH 85<sup>TH</sup> PERCENTILE SPEED
- 958 VEHICLES PER DAY
- FIRE DEPARTMENT DOES NOT OBJECT TO INSTALLATION
- SURVEY OF 129 AFFECTED PROPERTY OWNERS CONFIRMED AT LEAST 70% APPROVAL
- SURVEY OF 92 SECONDARILY AFFECTED PROPERTY OWNERS CONFIRMED LESS THAN 70% OPPOSITION

### TABLE 1: SPEED CUSHION SURVEY RESULTS

Within affected area	91 (71%)	38 (29%)
Within secondarily affected area	86 (93%)	6 (7%)
Outside affected and secondarily affected areas*	7 (30%)	16 (70%)
