Informational Update on Recent Council Action:

At its December 7, 2023 meeting, the City Council acknowledged the receipt of the minutes of the September 19, 2023 Transportation Advisory Board meeting.

At its November 20, 2023 meeting, the City Council passed and adopted Ordinance No. 5819, related to speed limits on Williams Field Road. The respective ordinance became effective 30 days after adoption.

Speed Limits (45 mph & 40 mph): 10-4-3 & 10-4-4

Amending Sections 10-4-3 and 10-4-4 of the Mesa City Code to establish a speed limit of 45 mph on Williams Field Road between Crismon Road and the east City limits, and a speed limit of 40 mph on Williams Field Road between Ellsworth Road and Crismon Road, as recommended by staff.
