4. Discuss and take action on the Accidental Disability Retirement application of Police Officer Jodi Valcik.

Chairperson Mickelsen welcomed Police Officer Jodi Valcik to the meeting. She stated that the members of the Local Board have reviewed the IME report from Dr. Jody Reiser. She encouraged the members to pose any questions they may have regarding the IME report and Officer Valcik's pending Accidental Disability Retirement application.

Boardmember Russell stated that the Local Board sent questionnaires for both Accidental Disability and Ordinary Disability to Dr. Reiser, to determine if Officer Valcik's current condition was caused by the reported work-related incident in 2007. He advised that Dr. Reiser's response on both questionnaires and in her IME report indicate that there are no conflicts in medical evidence, the condition is a direct result of Officer Valcik's on the job injury in 2007, and that she is totally and permanently unable to perform a reasonable range of duties within her job classification.

Chairperson Mickelsen indicated that in view of the absence of further questions from the Board, she would entertain a motion relative to this case.

It was moved by Boardmember Russell, seconded by Boardmember Lentz, that the Accidental Disability Retirement application of Police Officer Jodi Valcik be approved.

Upon tabulation of votes, it showed:

Chairperson Mickelsen thanked Police Officer Jodi Valcik for her service to the City.
