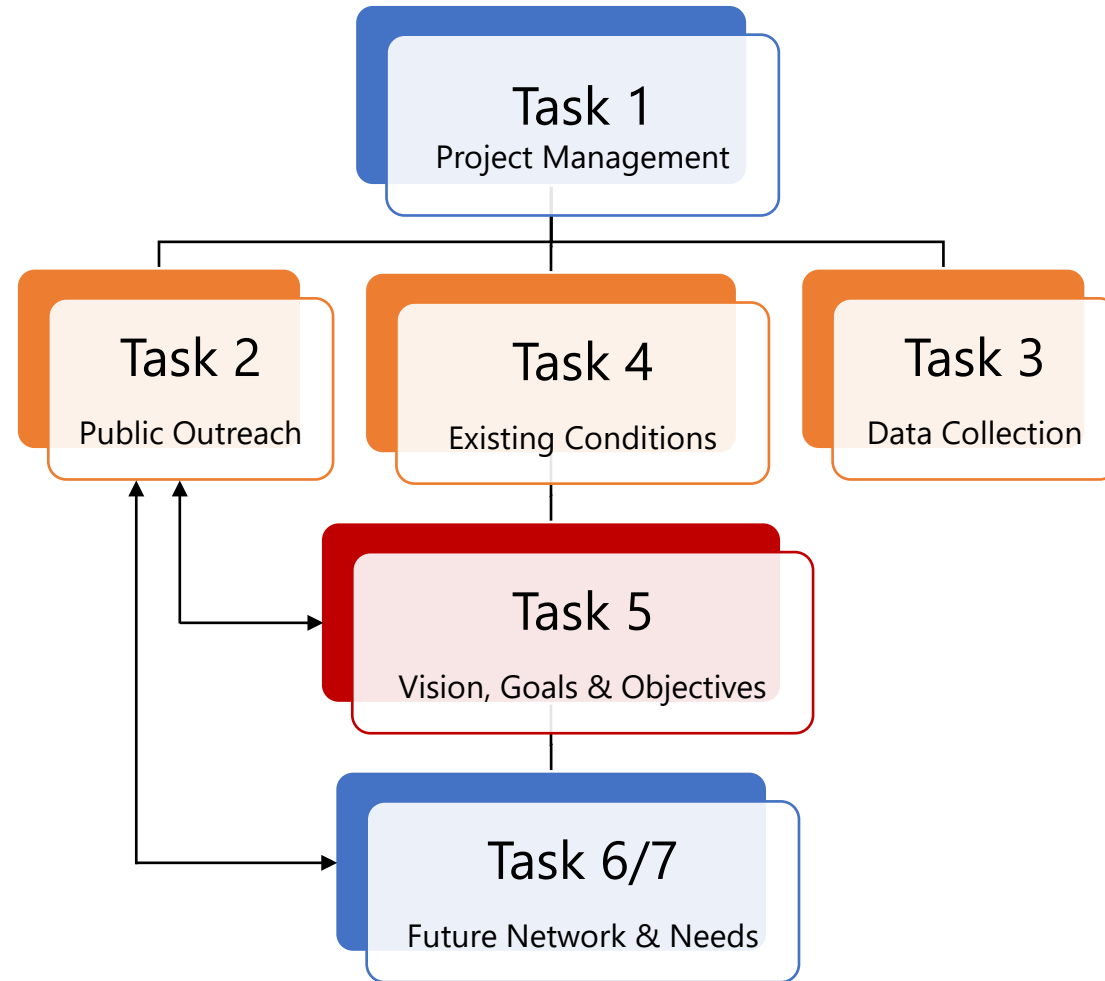
Overview



Purpose

- Create a statement of community vision and identify local and regional transportation needs for the short and long term.
- Develop a safe and efficient transportation system that provides access to all public places by multiple modes of travel and various users.
- Prepare a multi-modal future needs assessment, considering changes in technology and impacts on the use of public right-of way.
- Coordinate planning efforts and public outreach with Transit Master Plan, Housing Master Plan, and General Plan.
