Step 3: Conduct Speed Study (speed & volume)


Step 4: Neighborhood Acceptance Survey (300') If speed and volume criteria have been met At least **70% of affected owners** must approve


Step 5: Neighborhood Denial Survey (600') If 70% of affected owners approved Less than 70% of affected owners are opposed


DISCUSSION – DELTA AVENUE

- 25 MPH POSTED SPEED LIMIT
- 33.4 MPH 85TH PERCENTILE SPEED
- 1,301 VEHICLES PER DAY
- FIRE DEPARTMENT DOES NOT OBJECT TO INSTALLATION
- SURVEY OF 197 AFFECTED PROPERTY OWNERS CONFIRMED AT LEAST 70% APPROVAL
- SURVEY OF 122 SECONDARILY AFFECTED PROPERTY OWNERS CONFIRMED LESS THAN 70% OPPOSITION
