Chairperson Mickelsen excused Boardmember Castaneda from the meeting.

1. Approval of the minutes of the Public Safety Local Fire and Police Pension Boards meeting of October 20, 2022.

Boardmember Russell stated that he was absent from the October 20, 2022 meeting, yet he is listed as speaking on Item 8.

City Clerk staff thanked Boardmember Russell for pointing out the error and advised that the error will be corrected to list Boardmember Lentz who spoke on that item.

It was moved by Boardmember Sheppard, seconded by Boardmember Lentz, that the minutes of the Public Safety Local Fire and Police Pension Boards meeting of October 20, 2022 be approved with the noted correction.

Upon tabulation of votes, it showed:

FIRE PENSION BOARD

 Discuss and take action on the Accidental Disability Retirement application of Fire Captain Scott Peloquin.

Chairperson Mickelsen welcomed Fire Captain Scott Peloquin to the meeting. She stated that the members of the Local Board have reviewed the IME report from Dr. Giraldo Kato. She indicated that Dr. Kato agrees with the findings of Mr. Peloquin's attending physician, that Mr. Peloquin's condition was incurred in the performance of his duty, and that his condition totally and permanently prevents him from performing a reasonable range of duties within his job classification. She encouraged the members to pose any questions they may have regarding Mr. Peloquin's pending Accidental Disability Retirement application.

Chairperson Mickelsen indicated that in view of the absence of questions from the Board, she would entertain a motion relative to this case.

It was moved by Boardmember Silides, seconded by Boardmember Brady, that the Accidental Disability Retirement application of Fire Captain Scott Peloguin be approved.

Upon tabulation of votes, it showed:

Subsequent to a review of all medical reports, Local Boardmembers requested the record reflect that applicants Dallin Ashcroft, Angila Gomez, Austin Lara, Logan Magee, Hayden Minarchin, Bradley Stockton, Jose Toledo, Tod Workman, and Zachary Zastrow have pre-existing medical conditions.

It was moved by Boardmember Lentz, seconded by Boardmember Russell, that Law Enforcement applicants Dallin Ashcroft, Angila Gomez, Austin Lara, Logan Magee, Hayden Minarchin, Bradley Stockton, Jose Toledo, Tod Workman, and Zachary Zastrow be certified subject to the pre-existing medical conditions as noted.

4. Discuss and take action on the Accidental Disability Retirement application of Police Officer Jared Organ.

Chairperson Mickelsen welcomed Police Officer Jared Organ to the meeting. She stated that the members of the Local Board have reviewed Officer Organ's application and medical records. She encouraged the members to pose any questions they may have regarding Officer Organ's pending Accidental Disability Retirement application.

Discussion ensued relative to Officer Organ's injuries, subsequent treatments, and current condition.

Chairperson Mickelsen indicated that in view of the absence of further questions from the Board, she would entertain a motion relative to this case.

It was moved by Boardmember Russell, seconded by Boardmember Lentz, that Accidental Disability Retirement applicant, Police Officer Jared Organ, be sent for Independent Medical Evaluations.
