Informational Update on Recent Council Action:

At its June 6, 2024 meeting, the City Council acknowledged the receipt of the minutes of the March 19, 2024 Transportation Advisory Board meeting.

At its May 20, 2024 meeting, the City Council passed and adopted Ordinance No. 5850, related to the speed limit on 32nd Street. The respective ordinance became effective 30 days after adoption.

Speed Limit (30 mph & 25 mph): 10-4-6 & 10-4-7

Amending Section 10-4-6 of the Mesa City Code to modify the existing speed limit from 30 mph to 25 mph on North 32nd Street between McKellips Road and McDowell Road as recommended by the Transportation Advisory Board.
