Informational Update on Recent Council Action:

At its March 6, 2025 meeting, the City Council acknowledged the receipt of the minutes of the November 19, 2024 Transportation Advisory Board meeting.

At its May 12, 2025 meeting, the City Council passed and adopted Ordinance No. 5939, related to the speed limits on Val Vista Drive. The respective ordinance will become effective 30 days after adoption.

Speed Limit (40 mph & 35 mph): 10-4-4 & 10-4-5

Amending Sections 10-4-4 and 10-4-5 of the Mesa City Code to modify the limits of the existing posted speed limit of 40 mph on Val Vista Drive between Pomegranate Street and Quenton Drive and establish a speed limit of 35 mph on Val Vista Drive between Quenton Drive and the north City limits, as recommended by the Transportation Advisory Board.
