## RESOLUTION NO. 11701

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA AND THE CITY OF MESA CONCERNING THE REHABILITATION OF A SEWER LINE ALONG THE WESTERN CANAL IN TEMPE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approving the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Tempe, Arizona ("Tempe") and the City of Mesa (City), which identifies and defines the responsibilities of Tempe and the City concerning the rehabilitation of a jointly owned sewer interceptor along the Western Canal in Tempe, along with the concurrent rehabilitation of a nearby City of Mesa sewer main.

<u>Section 2</u>: That the City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, is authorized to enter into the agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, on behalf of the City of Mesa, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the City Manager or his authorized designated representative thereon.

Section 3: That the various City officers and employees be and hereby are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary to give effect to this Resolution.
