A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO TASK FORCE AGREEMENTS WITH THE ORGANIZED CRIME DRUG ENFORCEMENT TASK FORCES UNDER THE FEDERAL DRUG ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION TO ACCEPT UP TO \$50,000 DURING FISCAL YEAR OCTOBER 1, 2021 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2022, FOR OVERTIME AND OTHER AUTHORIZED EXPENSES FOR MESA POLICE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL ASSIGNED TO THE TASK FORCES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approving and authorizing the City Manager, or his designee, to enter into Task Force Agreements, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, with the Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Forces under the federal Drug Enforcement Administration to accept up to \$50,000 during fiscal year October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022. The funds will be used for overtime and other authorized expenses for Mesa Police Department personnel assigned to the task forces.

Section 2: Approval by the City Attorney or designee and signature by the City Manager or designee of the Task Force Agreements, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, shall constitute conclusive evidence of this City Council's approval thereof.
